application procedures

Two-week programs

Fill out the application pages completely, as well as relevant sections of the recommendation form. Your school official will complete it confidentially and send to us by the May 15 deadline. Be sure to provide your school official with a pre-addressed, postage-paid envelope and notify them of the May 15 deadline. It is your responsibility to see that the school official submits materials by the appropriate deadline.

We recommend that you submit your application materials well before the application deadline, as some programs fill up quickly.

All 2-week applications must include the following:

1. Application pages
2. Teacher recommendation
3. Official high school transcripts (including current year of study)
4. \$50 non-refundable application fee (will be deducted from program cost)
(Make check payable to: Syracuse University Summer College or, for VISA/MasterCard, use credit card section of application.)

Additional Application Requirements:

Studio Art program applicants must also submit a portfolio of 5 to 10 photographs or slides of recent work. All samples must be labeled with the applicant's name and date the work was completed. Applicants must include a self-addressed, stamped envelope large enough to return the portfolio.

Education program applicants must also submit an essay answering one of the following questions:

1. How did you become a reader? Craft a narrative essay about your memories of learning to read. Share your story of becoming a reader, recollections of reading in multiple settings, inside and outside of school, and your current experiences with reading.
2. What text has had the most impact on your life? How does this text influence the choices that you make about various aspects of your life (for example, academic and career goals, friendships, relationships)? This text can be a work of fiction, nonfiction, poetry, a collection of short stories, or other literary genre. Provide a brief summary of this text and explain how it connects to your own life experiences.
3. You have been asked to form a student committee to review the current literature requirements for the 9th grade curriculum at your high school. Name 3 texts that you feel every incoming 9th grader should read and explain your selections. Provide a convincing argument for adopting these 3 texts to your English literature department.

Instructions for international students

Please complete the international student application in addition to completing all items described above. Application deadline for international students is March 30, 2009.

Deadlines

The postmark deadline for completed applications is May 15, 2009. Earlier applications are strongly encouraged because most programs have limited enrollment. All applications are processed in the order they are received. Late applications may be accepted for programs not filled.

NOTE: Program dates listed above begin on a Monday and end on a Friday. Residential students should plan to move into the residence hall on the Sunday prior to the start of their program and are permitted to remain in residence until noon on the Saturday following the conclusion of their program.

Costs

Listed fees are per two-week program. Students are permitted to apply to multiple programs on one application.

Interior Design & Studio Art Programs, non-credit

Education & Management Programs, non-credit

Residential \$1,845
Commuter \$1,178*

Education Program, 3-credit option

The Education program offers a 3-credit option for students who want to receive college credit.

Residential \$2,819
Commuter \$2,152*

*Commuting students do not pay housing or meal charges.

Incidental Deposit: All students must provide an incidental deposit of \$75, which is refunded in the fall if no charges are assessed by Syracuse University.

Payment methods and deadlines

Students are required to guarantee their place in the program by submitting a \$500 deposit (per program if applying for multiple programs) within three weeks of receipt of the acceptance letter. This deposit is refundable until 5 p.m. on Friday, May 22, 2009. Refund requests must be made in writing. A maximum of three additional payments may be made for the remaining balance. Applicants must pay in full on or before June 19, 2009. Payment must be made in U.S. currency by check, money order, MasterCard, or Visa. Allow time for check clearance. All payments must be sent to Syracuse University, Summer College, 700 University Avenue, Syracuse NY 13244-2530.

Application materials can be submitted separately but applications will not be reviewed until all required materials have been received. Make sure to provide your school officials with enough time to ensure your application is received prior to the application deadline.
